THE AGE PRINCIPLE OF HISTORICAL ANALYSIS AND ITS METHODOLOGICAL POTENTIAL

The article reveals the insufficiency of the purely chronological criterion to differentiate eras in historical process. This criterion corresponds to mechanicalness of classical science. The article elaborates need of its addition to the essential criterion, which allows to investigate internal logic of historical process. The age principle of the historical analysis is the required essential principle. T.N.Granovsky, a historian, the representative of the Russian organicism of the 19th century, elaborated on the thought of importance of this principle as methodological basis of historical knowledge. The article briefly states the internal logic of history of the West European and domestic philosophy on the base of this principle. It leads to the conclusion about organic unity of world historical-philosophical process and its national features
